

# Food Pantry

## Statistics

**In 2014** 1,260,355 lbs of food and 11,359 shopping visits were made by 1,489 single person households & 2,182 family households.

**In 2015** 1,298,157 lbs and 12,051 shopping visits were made at the food pantry by 1,250 single person households & 2,323 family households.

Average households served monthly is 1,100

Average pounds distributed monthly is 130,000

The Food Pantry is a program that provides families in need with emergency food once a month. The food pantry distributes perishable and non-perishable groceries to families in need, three days per week. The amount of food distributed depends on the available food supply and the size of the family. Participants must provide proof of identity, number of household members and income; along with proof of residency. The food pantry is staffed by a full-time manager, a full-time assistant and a full-time warehouse manager, as well as over 300 volunteers and groups, who help unpack donation trucks, sort, stock shelves and assist shoppers.

The Food Pantry also packs “senior” boxes, which are on average of 366 a month; the senior boxes are an extra box of staple food (such as cereal, juice, proteins, vegetables and fruits) about 200 of them are delivered by Volunteers from our food pantry to senior living facilities and homes, while another 200 are picked up at the food pantry.
