Statistics

In 2014 the soup kitchen served 31,284 evening meals, and 11,042 breakfast and lunch meals to our shelter families

In 2015 the soup kitchen served 31,833 evening meals and 6,192 breakfast and lunch meals to our shelter families.

The Soup Kitchen has volunteers and staff who prepare and serve a complete balanced and nutritious meal to needy children, families and individuals. The kitchen provides a hot meal including soup, entrée, vegetable or potato, choice of sandwich, fruit, desert, milk, juice or coffee. For more than 30 years a daily meal has been served between 4:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m., seven days a week, 365 days per year. We currently average 100 guests each evening. There are no eligibility requirements; everyone who attends receives a free meal. The soup kitchen is staffed by a full-time soup kitchen coordinator, part-time soup kitchen supervisors and 50 different volunteer groups that provide 10-12 volunteers per night.
